New Delhi: A section of local telecom equipment makers is worried that the draft rules on local sourcing for government procurement of telecom gear do not mention 5G equipment, but the industry broadly believes the proposed rules will bolster domestic manufacturing.

The draft guidelines on public procurement with preference to 'Make in India' released by the telecommunications department (DoT) on Thursday has identified 36 products that must have over 50% local value addition while also laying out rules that should be followed for buying these products by the central government and its affiliated entities.

Since preference will be given to local companies that are making these products in India, the move will help develop an ecosystem in the country, industry officials said.

"This will encourage a higher level of indigenous production and innovation, positioning India as a leading nation for the export of telecom equipment," Mahendra Nahata, managing director of local gear maker HFCL, told ET.

The list of products where the minimum local content has to be over 50% include routers, ethernet switches, media gateways, customer premises equipment, GPON equipment, satellite phones and terminals, optical fibre and cable and telecom batteries. On certain products, the minimum

Mumbai: Adani Green Energy has won a bid to supply 6,600 MW of solar led renewable and thermal power in Maharashtra.

The renewable energy company said in a regulatory filing on Sunday it will sign a 25-year purchase agreement (PPA) with the Maharashtra State Electricity Distribution Company Ltd (MSEDCL) for supply of 5,000 MW solar power from the largest renewable energy park built at Khavda in Gujarat's Kutch district. Additionally, Adani Power has secured the largest private thermal power
