The procurement of paddy in mandis across the state will begin on Tuesday. Chief Minister Bhagwant Mann has reportedly assured the commission agents (arhtiyas) to take up their case with the Government of India.

The has also reportedly assured the arhtiyas that in case the Centre does not accede to their demand for restoration of their commission at 2.5 per cent of the MSP for paddy, the state government will cover the balance amount. Since 2019 onwards, the Centre had capped the arhtiyas' commission at Rs 46 per quintal.

Yesterday, the commission agents had threatened to lock the mandis from Tuesday, if their demands were not met.

A compromise has been

reached even as representatives of various farmer unions affiliated to the Samyukt Kisan Morcha (SKM) came here to demand that the paddy procurement be started immediately.

These leaders wanted to meet the CM, but they instead met some of his officers. They refused to go back and continued to stay at the Punjab Bhawan till the paddy procurement did not start.

CM Mann, in a statement issued later, said he would take up their demands with the Centre and provide them with legal help. "The agents have also assured me that the paddy purchase will be done in a smooth manner. My government will take care of them," he said. Vijay Kalra, president of the Federation of Arhtiya Associations of Punjab, said only the issue of labour rates needed to be resolved.

Eighteen cases of farm fire were reported across the state with the highest number of paddy residue burning reported in Amritsar (five), followed by Sangrur (four), Mansa (three) and Tarn Taran (two).

One case each was reported in Bathinda, Malerkotla, Faridkot and Ferozepur.

Amritsar has become the first district to report over 100 farm fire incidents. The holy city has reported 101 incidents of paddy residue burning so far.

There were reports of setting the paddy residue on fire during the evening at Bhattian village in Ludhi-



ana, but the incident was not mentioned in the farm fire report.

An agriculture expert said due to slow procurement of paddy much of the crop was yet to be harvested and the number of farm fires would witness a sudden spike around panchayat elections when the enforcement agencies would be busy maintaining law and order.

A total of 214 incidents were recorded this year, compared to 877 during the last year.

# India's Clean Energy Capacity to Rise Further by 2030: S&P

**Delhi:** India's clean energy technology capacity is projected to rise significantly by 2030, according to S&P Global commodity Insights. In line with its commitment to reduce carbon emissions and economic growth, India is positioning itself as a leader in clean energy manufacturing, it said.

Indian government has rolled out six initiatives, including the Production-Linked Incentive (PLI) scheme, aimed at attracting significant investment in solar modules and battery production," Jessica Jin of S&P Global Commodity Insights said. "These efforts not only aim to meet the country's growing electric demand but also strategically position India as a major player in the global energy supply chain."

With a surge in domestic demand coupled with favorable local policies, India is fostering local manufacturing in the solar and battery sectors.

Government measures, including tariffs on imported goods and services (IT), along with approved manufacturing and model lists have been introduced to boost domestic production, it said. Tax incentives, such as the production-linked incentive scheme, further aim to boost domestic production and innovation within the sector, it said.

Favorable policies are expected to drive substantial growth in India's clean energy capacity by 2030. Projections indicate that India will reach 7 GW in [solar] PV modules, 20 GW in nacelles, 69 GWh in battery cells, and 30 GW in electrolyzers, it said.

This growth will enable India to achieve self-sufficiency in solar PV and other clean energy technologies, it said. "We in electrolyzers, it said. According to the statement, IEX achieved total monthly (trade) volume (including certificates) of 11,370 MU in September 2024, marking a 24% year-over-year increase.
